HOUSE RULES

NOTE CAREFULLY

The judgement in matters of dress or behaviour shall be the right of the Manager. In the absence of the Manager - any Member of the General Committee or the person in charge of the bar at the time.

DRESS: Minimum standard at all times for Members and guests

Lounge, Dining and Function areas

Respectable dress with minimum shirt with sleeves, shorts and suitable footwear at all times. (tanktops, singlets and shirts without sleeves, thongs and bathers) **are not permitted at any time.** Normal standards of ladies dress fashions are acceptable.

Southern Bar

Shirt with sleeves, shorts and thongs as minimum footwear. (tanktops, singlets and shirts without sleeves, bathers and barefeet) **are not permitted at any time.** Normal standards of ladies dress fashions are acceptable.

Fisherman's Bar

Shirts without sleeves, tank tops, singlets, thongs and bathers.

Bare feet not permitted at any time.

The Liquor License does not permit Strippers in the Club. No hats, caps or beannies are to be worn inside the Clubhouse at any time. This excludes the Boat Shed.

HOUSE RULES

No persons shall use bad or questionable language in the Club premises at any time. Members are expected to show guests every consideration with particular emphasis on occasions where competitions are in progress. Riotous behaviour will not be tolerated under any circumstances.

1. All Members and guests are required to treat all Club property and facilities with proper care.
2. Each Member shall be responsible for the dress and the behaviour of his guests. **There is no smoking permitted in the Club premises.**
3. **All vehicles must be parked within the marked bays.**
RESTRICTED PARKING. The 5 minute parking bay is strictly reserved for takeaway purchases only. Members and guests shall not park in the Club Manager's bay during office and club trading hours.
NO PARKING is permitted in the area adjacent to the entry and exit to the boat launching ramp. Prior to 4pm on any day on which a fishing competition is in progress only vehicles with boat trailers attached may park in the Northern car park.
Parking violations will result in suspension of membership.
4. No dogs or other pets are permitted in or on Club premises.
5. Advertising of or for any commercial product or enterprise is not permitted at any time except with written approval from General Committee. Such approval will be for a maximum of 12 months.
6. No signs to be displayed on the southern, western or northern windows.
7. No games of Pool or Darts shall commence later than 10 minutes prior to the cessation of trading.
8. No persons under the age of 18 years are permitted in the Southern and Fisherman's bar areas other than on occasions of special events of the Club as prescribed by the General Committee from time to time. Members or persons under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by, and under the supervision of a responsible adult.
9. There shall be no bar trading outside of the advertised hours.
10. There shall be no illegal gambling of any kind.
11. Each Member is permitted to introduce five visitors at any one time to the Club. This requirement must be observed for the areas known as the Southern bar, the Fishermen's bar and the Members lounge. The Function Room and Restaurant area, when used for dining are not subject to this restriction.
12. Guests are not permitted to remain on the premises after the host Member has departed.
13. Guests are not permitted to buy take-away liquor at any time.
14. The sale of jugs shall cease not later than 10 minutes prior to the advertised hour for the cessation of trading.
15. All take-away liquor must be purchased and removed from the premises not later than the advertised hour for the cessation of normal trading.
16. No take-away liquor may be purchased during that period for which a late licence is in effect.
17. All persons must vacate the premises not longer than 15 minutes after the advertised hour for the cessation of trading.

18. Any person can and will be refused bar service, if, in the opinion of the person on bar duty or any Member of the General Committee, consider that further service is unwarranted.
19. Any person asked by the person on bar duty or any Member of the General Committee to leave the premises shall do so without question.
20. No person shall enter the area behind the bar unless properly authorised to do so. No person shall use the area behind the bar as an access to another area of the premises or to utilise any facility.
21. No person shall remain in or obstruct free access to that area set aside for service only.
22. No person shall remain in the area of the Southern Bar, when the area is required for an official Club function, later than one hour prior to the advertised commencing time of that function.
23. Any calls received on a mobile phone can be answered inside Club premises.

NOTE: Any breach of these house rules may lead to the suspension of the offending Member or Members.

BOAT SHED RULES

1. No combustible fuel shall be left or stored in the boat shed at any time.
2. No offal fish burley or other offensive material to be left in, or stored in the boat shed.
3. Boats are not permitted to be left in such a manner as to obstruct free access and exit from the boat shed, boat deck or any ramp.
4. Visitors not in the company of a Member known to them are not permitted in the boat shed.
5. Under no circumstances is the lending of any key to the boat shed, launching ramp or other Club facility permitted.
6. No boat in excess of 4.4 metres shall be stored in the boat shed at any time.
7. Any malfunction of or any damage to boat shed equipment must be reported to the Manager or any Member of the House Committee forthwith.
8. Boatshed storage will be with the approval of General Committee.
